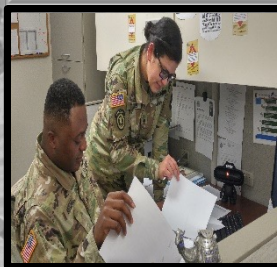

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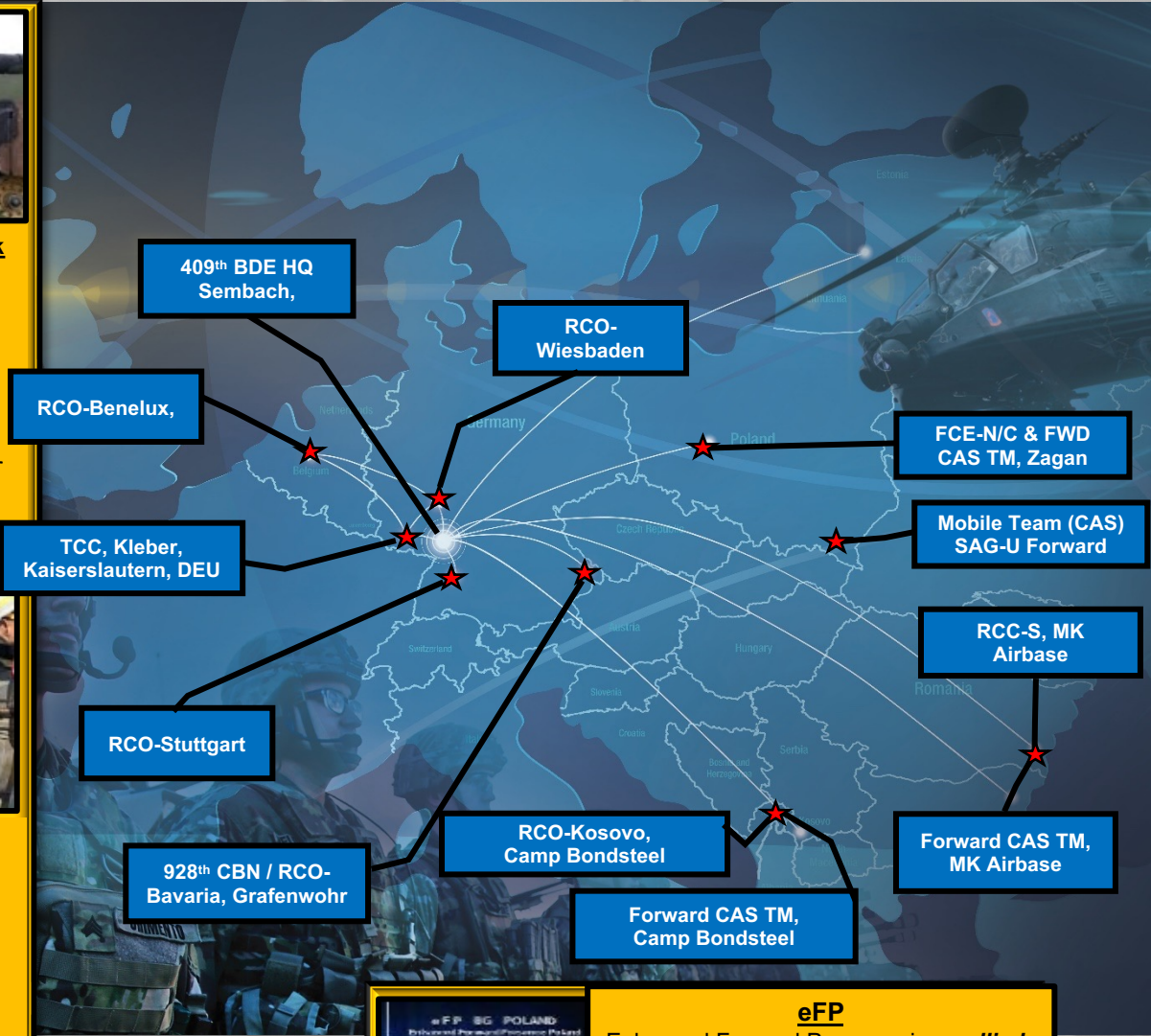
Army Prepositioned Stock -2 Europe

The EAS is a combined-arms, battalion-sized group of vehicles and equipment that is **prepositioned in Europe** to outfit U.S. Army Regionally Aligned Forces when they rotate into theater for training or **contingency operations**.



Base Life Support Services

LOGCAP provides **comprehensive** sustainment, services, & minor construction through its own external contracts, and **supports EUCOM** operational planning with logistics processes to ensure **effective** sustainment service delivery.



eFP

Enhanced Forward Presence is an **allied**, forward deployed **defense and deterrence** posture in Eastern Europe to protect and reassure NATO's Eastern member states of their **security**.



V CORPS

2 DIV HQ Elements and 5 BCTs commit troops to Europe in support of the **Geographic Combatant Commander**. It provides the United States Army, Europe, a unique set of capabilities and greater **flexibility** to respond to future **contingencies**.



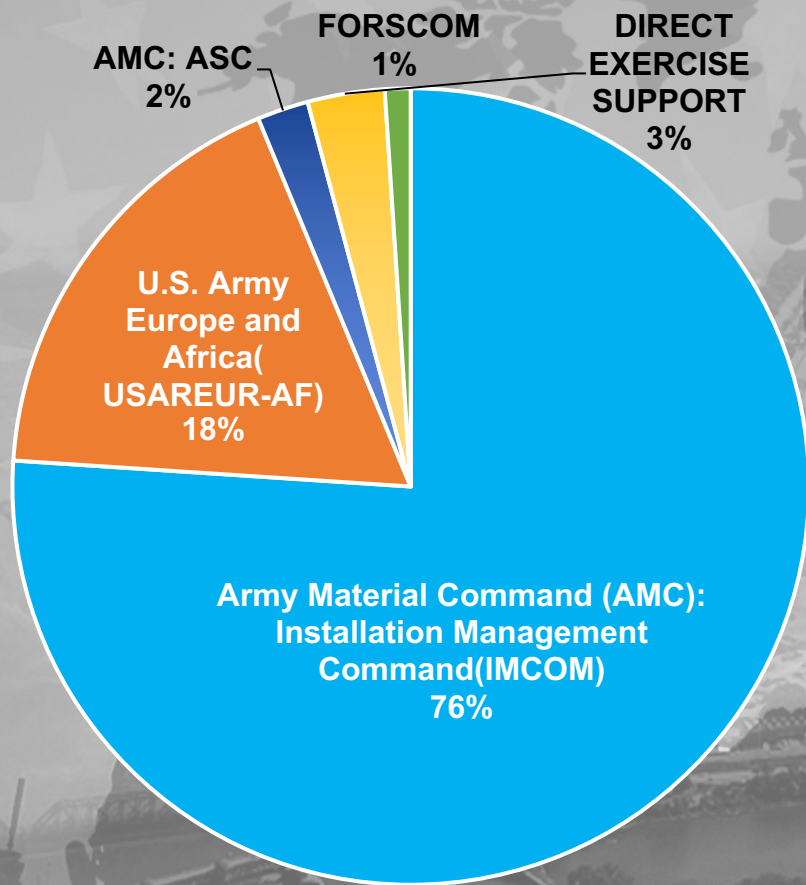

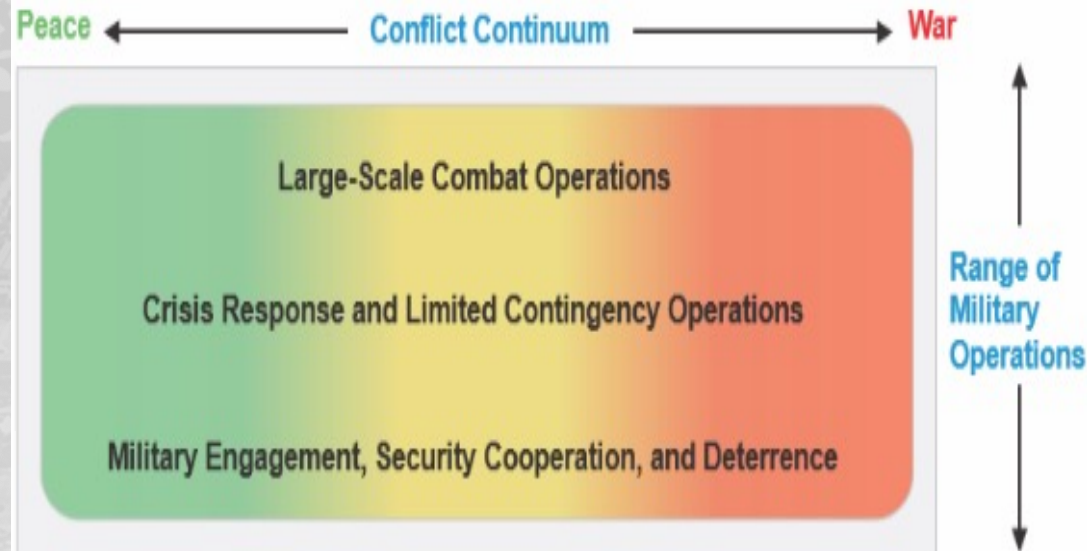


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Changes Driving 409th CSB Mission Growth

 - Installation Management Command- Europe (IMCOM-E) growth – Stand-up of U.S. Army Garrison (USAG) Poland and Black Sea Theater
 - Support to Partners and Allies in EUCOM AOR: collective training with Allies and Partner nations

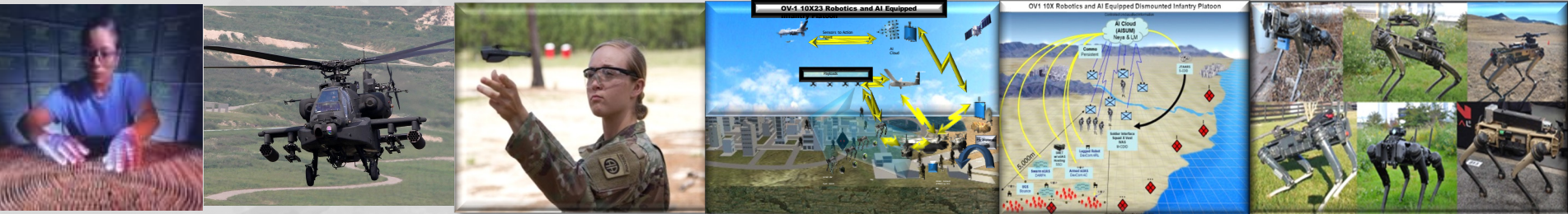
Notional Operations Across the Conflict Continuum

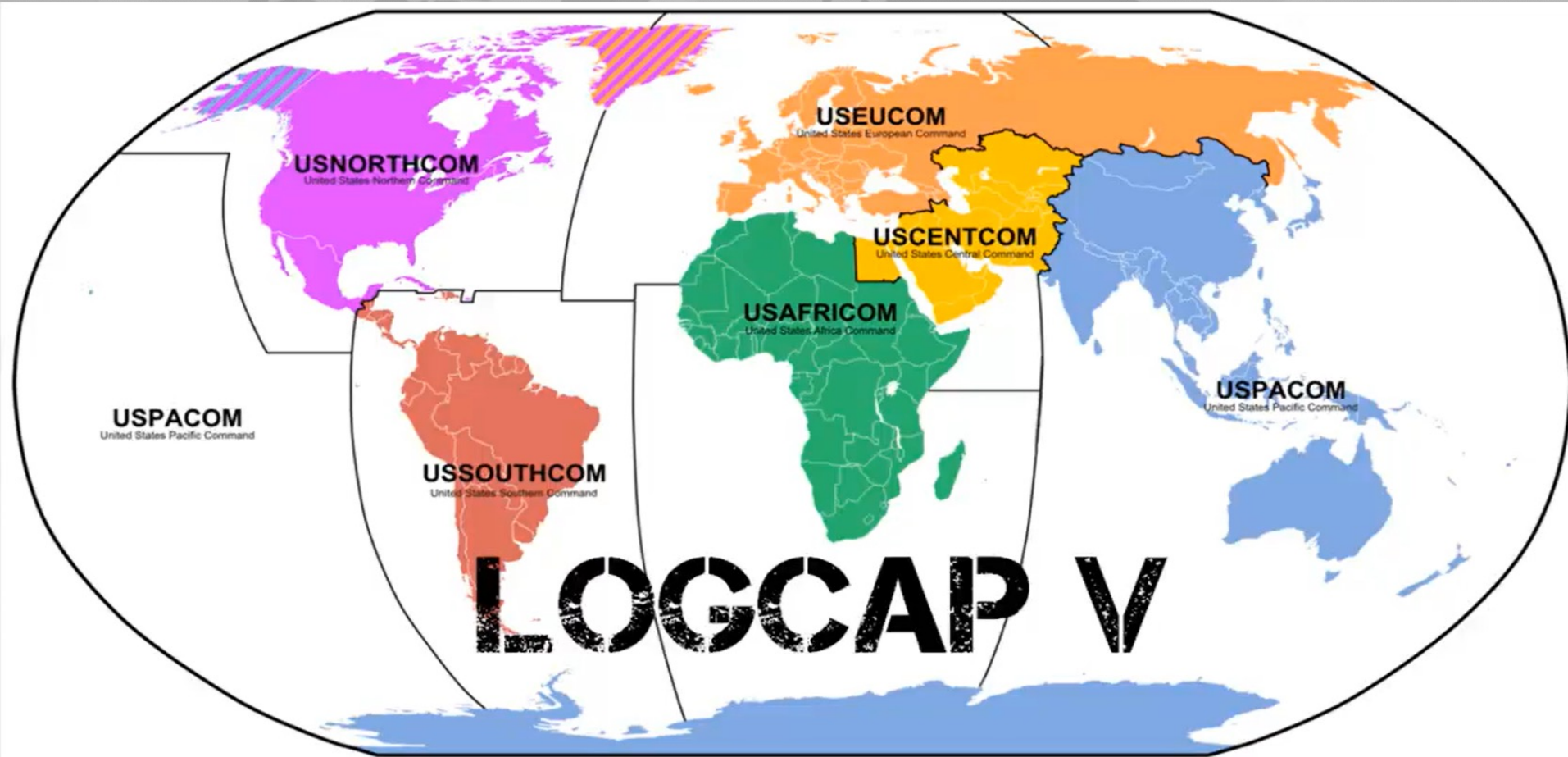

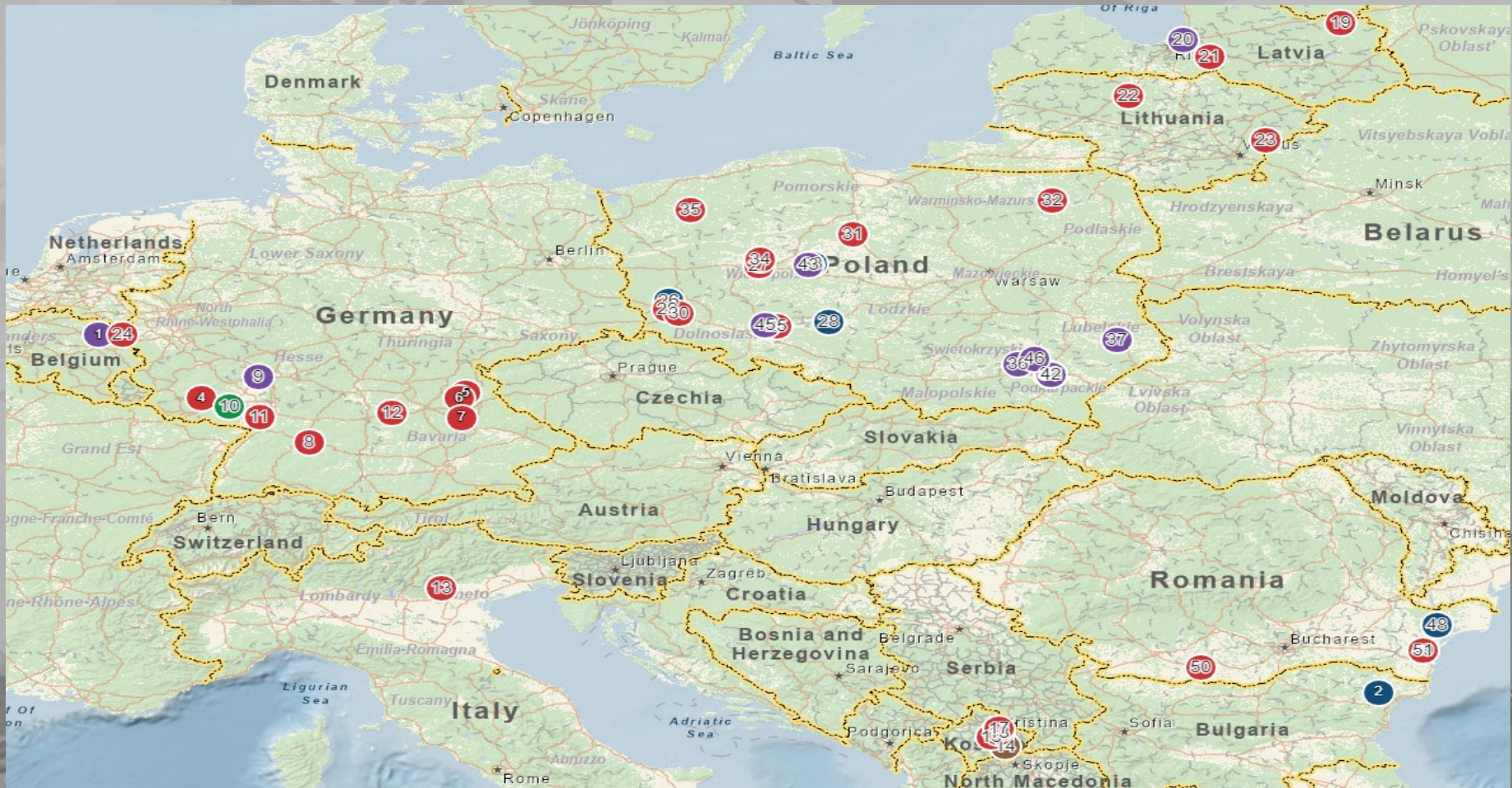

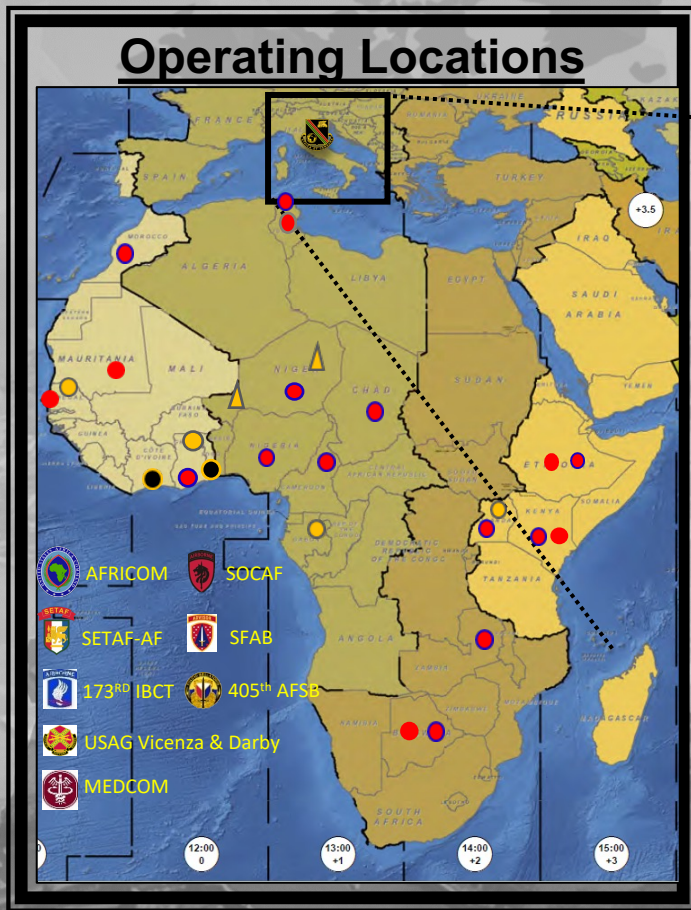

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Theater Short Term Requirements

- **Local transportation** (troop/material movement)
 - NTVs, bus, line haul, rail team support, etc...
- **Local Small Construction Actions**
 - Building repairs, hangars, kennels, (real property)
- **Local Base Life Support (BLS)**
 - Full food service, showers, laundry facilities/services, MHE, and road work/repair, tailorable convoy support at ROM/FLE site
- **Commodities**
 - Gravel, IT equipment, portable latrines, and office equipment
