

Security Assistance Group-Ukraine (SAG-U) is a dedicated headquarters established to provide a long-term, focused organizational structure to coordinate and oversee the full-spectrum of security assistance to the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

- Comprised of joint and multinational service members, including personnel from more than 25 nations in the co-located **International Donor Coordination Center (IDCC)**. The IDCC coordinates resources from among the international community to enable donor countries from around the world to provide military equipment, training, and aid to Ukraine.

EQUIP

- Connect Armed Forces of Ukraine demand with donor coalition supply.
- Cohere collective efforts in provision of military aid.
- Innovate novel solutions to new and existing challenges.

TRAIN

- Coordinate, integrate, and synchronize multinational training efforts.
- Maintain training unity of effort through standardization and coordination.
- Build capability from materiel donations through meeting Ukrainian training demands.



- Support regeneration and reconstitution of capabilities and materiel.
- Provide maintenance support, spares, and advice.
- Coordinate complex movement support and donation tracking.

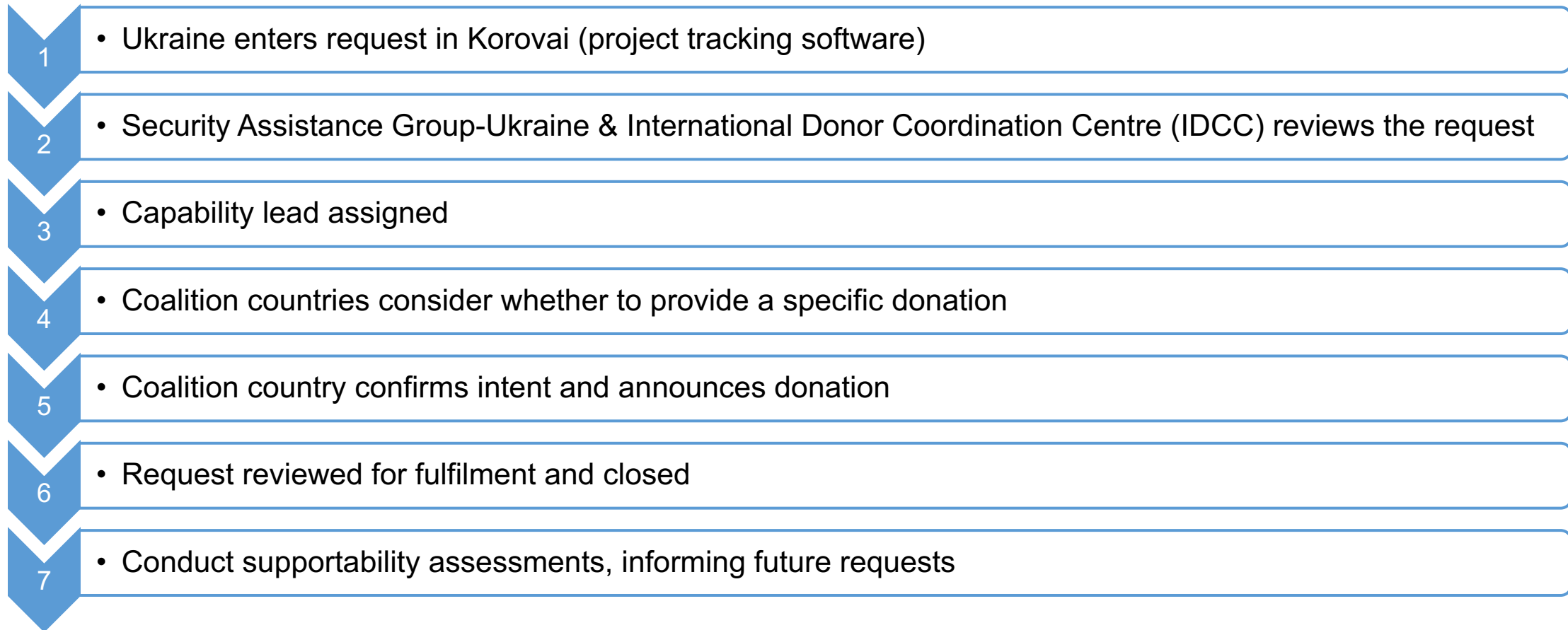
SUSTAIN

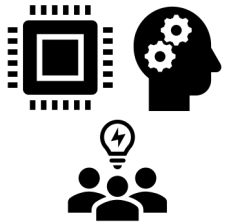
MIM-23 Hawk Missile Launcher

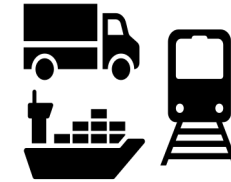

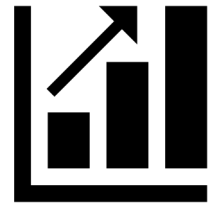
